### ► Webinars

Renowned poet and filmmaker Sri Sreekumaran Thampi was conferred the first CETAAT Devarajan Master Puraskaram, followed by a nostalgic address by him.

Twenty-four songs written by Sri Vayalar Ramavarma and one song written by Sri Sreekumaran Thampi were performed by our CETAAT members-each performance was outstanding. The show extended over four hours, and the sincere efforts of the Devaragasandhya Organising Committee and the Ragatharangam team were duly recognized by the MC.

## LEADERS WHO INFLUENCED THE NATION-FROM CET

The College of Engineering Trivandrum (CET) started functioning in 1939, under the University of Travancore, which itself was established in 1937, by the then Maharaja of Travancore, Sree Chitra Thirunal Balarama Varma. The college started functioning on 3rd July 1939 at the premises of the present PMG office and the Kerala State Science and Technology Museum. The college was shifted to the present location at Kulathur in 1961. Students then doing their final years in 1961 -1962, had the privilege to be the first batch to graduate from the new premises.

In its nascent phase, CET offered degree courses only in three branches viz. Civil, Mechanical and Electrical Engineering. Diploma courses were also offered in the same engineering streams. In 1939, 21 students were admitted for the degree course and same numbers of students were enrolled for the diploma courses. Besides this, there was also a certificate course with 40 students. Though seven seats were allotted for each branch of Civil, Mechanical and Electrical engineering, some of the seats in the electrical branches were not filled in some of the academic years. Adjustments were made among the branches in order to maintain the total number of seats. Thus, the first batch to pass out in 1943 had 11 civil, 5 mechanical and 3 electrical graduates.

The name and fame of an educational institution is amplified by its illustrious Alumni and the College of Engineering Trivandrum (CET) is no exception. CET boasts of many multifaceted engineers, academicians and administrators among its alumni, who adorned or are adorning the top positions in institutions all over the globe. Among them are leaders who have guided and inspired the younger generation.

### Er.R. BALAKRISHNAN NAIR



We are pleased to feature Er. R. Balakrishnan Nair in the LEADERS column of this issue. A 1958 Civil Engineering graduate from CET, Er. Balakrishnan Nair completed his early schooling in Neyyattinkara and later studied at the Salvation Army School, Kowdiar, Thiruvananthapuram. He pursued his intermediate studies at the University Intermediate College before obtaining his B.Sc. (Engg.) in Civil Engineering from CET. Immediately after graduation, he joined the Kerala State Electricity Board (KSEB) as Junior Engineer, initially working at the head office in Thiruvananthapuram in the project design division. Over the next three decades, he served in various capacities in several major hydroelectric projects in Kerala.

He had a long tenure with the prestigious Idukki Hydroelectric Project, where, as Assistant Executive Engineer, he played a vital role in infrastructure development works. He was later transferred to the Chief Engineer's Office as Executive Engineer (Designs & Planning). Subsequently, he served as Executive Engineer for the execution of the Kuttiadi HEP and Kuttiadi Augmentation Schemes.

He also served as Deputy Chief Engineer, Kuttiadi HE Project, Kozhikode.

He was later promoted and posted as Chief Engineer (Planning & Research) at Vydyuthi Bhavanam, Thiruvananthapuram. In this role, Er. Balakrishnan Nair made significant contributions to the planning and development of numerous hydroelectric projects, preparing project reports for mini, small, and large HEPs. After more than 33 years of dedicated service, he retired in 1991 as Chief Engineer (Planning).

Following his retirement from KSEB, he joined Asian Tech Pvt. Ltd. as General Manager (Projects), overseeing the company's projects in Himachal Pradesh and Delhi from 1991 to 1993.

A recognized expert in water resources, Er. Balakrishnan Nair served as a technical witness for Kerala before the Cauvery Water Disputes Tribunal. His expertise in water resource analysis and dam design made him a valued advisor to the Government of Kerala on water management and dam safety.

Even after retirement, he remained active in social initiatives. He was the founder president of the Ambalamukku Residents' Association and also established the Kowdiar Veterans Group.

Er. Balakrishnan Nair earned a sterling reputation as a brilliant Engineer, equally proficient in planning,



design, and project execution. He was also a capable administrator, firm, efficient, and at the same time warm and cordial with colleagues, earning their respect and affection. An engineer of high competence, efficiency, and integrity, he was a role model for young generations.

His contributions to the Kerala power sector are truly commendable. After a long innings of hardwork he is now leading a peaceful retired life at Ambalamukku, Thiruvananthapuram. He was married to the late Smt. P. S. Santhakumari and has a daughter and a son.

## DEVARAGASANDHYA SEASON 6

CETAAT Devaragasandhya - Season 6, Vayalar Smrithiyil Randam Bhagam, was held at the iconic Tagore Theatre on 5<sup>th</sup> October 2025. This year's theme was a heartfelt tribute to the legendary lyricist Shri Vayalar Ramavarma, marking the 50<sup>th</sup> year of his passing. All the songs performed during the evening were timeless masterpieces penned by Vayalar and composed by Devarajan Master, rekindling the golden era of Malayalam film music.

A new milestone was introduced this year - the CETAAT Devarajan Master Puraskaram, instituted to honour artists who have made outstanding contributions to Malayalam film music. A distinguished three-member jury, consisting of senior CETAAT members Er. A.K. Nair, Er. Ravindran T. Nair, and chaired by Shri K. Jayakumar IAS (Retd.), former Chief Secretary and acclaimed poet, selected the first recipient of this award - the legendary Shri Sreekumaran Thampi.
